The Committee discussed and noted data for EYFS, KS1 and KS2. Data was also analysed from both ASP (Analyse School Performance) and FFT (Fischer Family Trust) Aspire. It was noted that attainment had been good, with positive progress, especially in KS2 maths.

It was noted that early year's data was now more robust. The new reception baseline assessment, this academic year, will provide a snapshot of where pupils are when they arrive at school, enabling a new starting point to measure the progress that they make by the end of year 6.
